

- Dual rubber pads combine for a premium grip









Mounting

Note: Mounting hardware not provided

- 1. When installing tools horizontally, position the sure grip so the post holding the strap is on the bottom. The flat area is where the tools can rest. The strap should be hanging down out of the way of the tool storage area (see cover).
- 2. If mounting vertically, sure grips can be placed in either orientation.
- 3. Place two sure grips in line so that each end of the tool is supported (see cover).
- Use two 1/4" bolts, nuts, and washers to mount Sure-Grips in the desired location. When mounting to Zico Aluminum Tool Boards use the 2" spaced mounting holes, we advise using Truss Head bolts.(See page 3)

Using

<u>Securing the Tool</u> (Shown below) Note: Item numbers in parentheses (see Page 2)

- 1. Place the tool so it is resting on the Sure-Grip base(1).
- 2. Wrap the strap(2) over the tool and loop it around the opposite post.
- 3. Pull the strap(2) away from the base(1) and over the tool to engage the hook and loop pads, press together to secure.

Removing the Tool

- 1. Grab the end of the strap(2) at the red tab and pull the hook and loop apart to release the connection.
- 2. Pull the tool away from the base(1), through the loosened strap.
- 3. Strap will free itself as you pull.
